Presentation: Literacy Update - Mrs. Hornung presented an update to the Board about the elementary classrooms that will be piloting new literacy curriculum based on the Science of Reading. She thanked the teachers for stepping forward and receiving training and working on the literacy curriculum to support students.

Discussion
