FAQ's

What is the Advanced Placement History Scholar Award?

It is an honor given to graduating seniors who demonstrate achievement in the social sciences. This award may be used as an example of excellence for the college application process.

Who is eligible?

All students enrolled in social studies Advanced Placement courses at O.P.H.S. are eligible for The Advanced Placement History Scholar Award.

What are the requirements to earn this distinction?

It is a distinction awarded to students who challenge themselves in social studies Advanced Placement courses. Each student must earn a four or five on at least two Advanced Placement exams in social studies before his/her senior year and be enrolled in a social studies Advanced Placement class senior year.

What Advanced Placement Courses are eligible?

Freshman year- Advanced World History 9

Sophomore year- Advanced Placement World History 10 or Advanced Placement European History

Junior year- Advanced Placement United States History

Senior year- Enrolled in an Advanced Placement U.S. Government and Politics, Advanced Placement Macro Economics, and/or Advanced Placement European History
