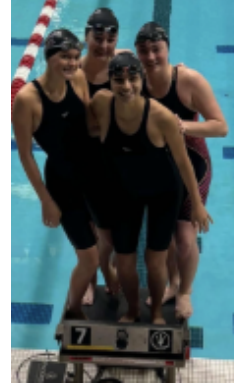
## Announcements and Points of Pride
