- What is Title I? It provides additional funds to support all students meet standards regardless of socio-economic status
- District receives funding and utilizes it; however, Windom is receiving 100% of the Title I funds awarded to Orchard Park due to the percentage of low-income families of Windom
- Funds must be supplement, not supplant – it is additional funding to support Windom's learners
- Literacy Curriculum: Reader's and Writer's Workshop and trainings
- Math: Investigations, Context for Learning
- Science: Smithsonian, hands on learning and exploration
- Progress monitoring: universal screenings, teacher designed assessments, progress reports (trimester)
