In past years, almost 400 students have attended the Post Prom Party. The students enjoyed entertainment, refreshments, and prizes. In 2024, the PTO gave away more than \$2,000 in prizes and \$3000 in cash, with one lucky senior winning the grand prize of \$2024.

#### From the High School Counseling Department

- College Night will take place Thursday, February 27th at 7pm in the OPHS Commons. Students
  (and parents) from all grade levels are encouraged to attend to hear from college admissions
  officers on a variety of topics related to the college admissions process. This event is a "must"
  for any junior planning on applying to college in the fall of their senior year.
- The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is now available for the 2025-2026 academic year. All students attending college in Fall 2025 and their parents need to complete the FAFSA. Click here for more information.
- The NYS TAP application is open for the 2025-2026 academic year. Click <u>here</u> for more information.
- Students attended a scheduling assembly on January 9th and learned how to enter their course requests for the 2025-26 school year. Students need to submit their course requests through their student portal by the end of the day on Friday, January 17th. Counselors will be meeting with students individually to review/update requests starting on Thursday, January 30th. Students have until June 1st to make changes to their requests.
- Canisius University is offering the "Buffalo Promise Scholarship" beginning in Fall 2025. This
  scholarship (valued at full tuition) is automatically offered to accepted students from zip codes
  starting with 142 with an adjusted household gross income at or less than \$125,000. Click


