Back in Blue!

On Friday, November 4, 2022, I had the pleasure of traveling to Washington, DC with OPCSD Superintendent, David Lilleck, and technology teacher, Emil Erlandson for the 2022 National Blue Ribbon Schools awards ceremony. Orchard Park High School was selected as a 2022 Exemplary High Achieving School. OPHS was one of 41 high schools in the country, and one of nine in New York State, to receive this award. Schools are nominated to apply for recognition by the United States Department of Education and the New York State Education Department. OPHS previously received this award in 2016 and is one of only three high schools in NYS to have been recognized with this distinction multiple times.

To receive this prestigious award is a tremendous honor for the students, parents, and staff of not only the high school but also the entire school district. Student performance at the high school level is a credit to the hard work and dedication of all parents and school staff from pre-kindergarten through grade 12. It is truly a team effort.

We are planning a school wide celebration of this recognition for Wednesday, November 30, 2022. A special thank you to the OPHS PTO for graciously volunteering to provide each student with a treat during the assembly period.

The month of November also signals the end of the first marking period and the posting of the first report card. Please review the report card with your student and feel free to contact his/her teachers or school counselor should you have any questions or concerns. We have several options available to provide extra help and support for students experiencing academic difficulty. Parents can also keep closer track of student progress by accessing the PowerSchool Parent Portal via the OPCSD website (https:// powerschool.opschools.org/).




