Dear Parents/Guardians of Current 7th grade Students:

World Affairs Club WAC is an 8th grade club focused on citizenship and pride in our great country. Students who join the club do so with the goal of a trip to Washington D.C. during the spring of their eighth grade year.

I would like to give you some information about the World Affairs Club's early registration process for next year's trip to Washington, D.C. All 7th graders are eligible to be members of the OPMS World Affairs Club and may choose to participate in the trip. Your child received an informational flyer from me and World Strides, the tour company which coordinates our trip to Washington, D.C.. *Please understand that your child's membership alone in the World Affairs Club DOES NOT register him/her for the trip to Washington, D.C. You MUST register your child YOURSELF. Please scan the QR Code at the bottom right of the flyer that your child brings home. You may also go online, www.worldstrides.com or call 800-468-5899, to register your child. Orchard Park Trip ID Number is 216070*

- ✓ Please take the time to carefully read all the information before registering your child so there is no confusion regarding any of the terms and conditions, price and payment information, or the cancellation policy. Please call World Strides directly if you have any further questions about any of their policies.
- ✓ Please note that <u>not included</u> in the trip cost shown are baggage fees being imposed by whatever airline we use to fly to Washington, D.C. At this time, we do not know which airline will be transporting our group and by law, the tour company cannot include baggage fees in their advertised pricing. If there are baggage fees, they must be paid by each traveler individually at the airport at check-in.
- ✓ There will be <u>one</u> fundraiser to help offset the cost of the trip. It will be held in the fall of your child's 8th grade school year. (October/ November)
- ✓ Fundraising profits earned by your child will be held until about 1 2 weeks prior to the trip, when a check will be issued to a parent/guardian in the amount of their earned profits. According to New York State law, students cannot be credited with profits which exceed the price of the trip. Any excess profits would be retained by the World Affairs Club.

Discount Info- If you register by June 28, 2024, you will receive a \$40 discount off the regular price, with an initial deposit of only \$49. You may register after June 28, 2024, however you will be charged the full regular price.

As we move through the remainder of this school year and into next year, I am sure you will have questions. Please do not hesitate to contact me. Entrepreneurship Elective Class Presentation- Mr. Roland & Mr. Gill

- · Four students from the class presented, along with Mr. Roland & Mr. Gill.
- Students have been designing & creating OP branded products & then selling them to the OPMS community. Some of the products they have already created include hats, string bags/backpacks, keychains, mini hockey sticks, & t-shirts. They are looking into additional opportunities through which the students can design & sell products.
- They presented an OP Welcome Bundle of some of their OP branded products. The Bundle would be sold at a
 discounted price & they thought it may be a good fit to include at the Back to School Celebration at the end of
 August. They offered to sell the products in coordination with the PTO & share a percentage of the earnings as a
 PTO fundraiser.
- PTO inquired about the possibility of offering student presales for OP t-shirts, so students can choose their design & size in advance and the Entrepreneurship class has time to make the products.

Principal's Report- Presented by Mrs. Graham

- The OPMS Observer newsletter will be going out today. Mrs. Graham is trying to consolidate the communications going out to keep down the volume of messaging.
- NYS Assessments have been underway. Science is the only assessment that still needs to be completed.
- Final exams are in one month.
- 8th Grade Algebra Regents Exam is on June 4th at the OP High School. They are currently working out transportation options.
- 6th Grade Field Trips, 7th Grade Field Day, & 8th Grade Daybreak, & end of year awards are all coming up.

- Treasurer's Report from April 16, 2024 through May 13, 2024 was presented.
- The 2024/2025 Proposed Budget was presented & discussed.

President's Report-Tara Womble

The 2024/2025 Budget will be finalized with Mrs. Graham on June 10, 2024. Budget is due July 1st.

PTO Teachers' Representative Report-Mrs. Baumgartner

 Thank you for the Staff Appreciation Luncheon on May 2nd. The food was wonderful & was very much appreciated by the school staff.

Committee Reports

- 6th & 7th Grade Spring Activity Night (05/10/2024, 6:00pm to 8:00pm)-Kathy Bielecki & Tara Womble. The event was a success, and all went smoothly. 383 students signed up to attend the event. This number broke down to 239 sixth graders & 144 seventh graders. 365 students signed-in at the event. The only difficulty of the night was making sure students knew that there was no reentry to the event if they left early to go to Subway or 7-Eleven. "No Reentry" will be posted on future event flyers. They will also require students to sign-out of the event if they leave the event early.
- Color Run (5/17/24, 5:00 to 7:00pm)-Tiffany Hsu & Jonelle Smith: Run takes place in 4 days & so far there are 11 students signed up for the event. Last year there were 87 students and they raised approximately \$3,000. The decision was made to postpone the event to a future date, with the hope of higher participation.
- Holocaust Speaker (05/20/2024)- Tara Womble: the event planning is complete & all is ready for Monday.
- 8th Grade Daybreak Celebration (06/07/2024)- Jennifer Kellington: Items for the event have been ordered. A volunteer request was put out and they should be in good shape for the event.
- 7th Grade Field Day (6/13/2024)- Erin Homer: Approximately 24 parent volunteers are needed for the event & a Sign-Up Genius will be sent out. Items for the event are in the process of being ordered, including games, supplies, popsicles, and water.


Building Effectiveness Team (BET)- Kathy Bielecki

• Discussed ways to improve getting information about the available school clubs and activities to students & their families. Ideas included producing pamphlets that describe available clubs & activities, including club/activity information on the school website, holding a school club fair, and scheduling presentations on clubs for the students.

Other Business:

- An attendee inquired about the possibility of having the Morning Announcement scripts posted to the school website, so it is easier for people to skim through the news to find what they need.
- A recommendation was made to ensure that students are aware of the early start for school play tryouts & other sports or activities that start at the very beginning of the new school year.
- A recommendation was made to text families during the summer to ensure they are aware of the Back to School celebration scheduled for the end of August. The idea of texting families as a preferable way of communicating was also discussed.
- A conversation was opened regarding how parents are invited to join the PTO & how we can increase the membership. The possibility of offering a free PTO membership, with the request of a donation, instead of the current required fee of \$5 was discussed.
- Mrs. Graham mentioned that they are discussing the possibility of bringing back some elective classes.
- Mrs. Graham discussed the idea of implementing digital hall passes, or E-hall passes, at school. The passes help keep kids safe & in class, by letting you know how much time kids are spending in the bathrooms. They also aid in preventing bathroom vandalism.


