Call to Order, Welcome & Introductions

Principal's Report-Presented by Mr. Wolf

• A candidate has been put forth for the principal position at the OPMS. If approved, the new principal will start after Spring Break.

8th Grade Celebration Discussion- Mr. Wolf on Behalf of the Event Student Council

• After conducting a poll of the 8th grade class, 80% of the students said that they prefer not having a dance & putting the dance funds toward the Daybreak Celebration. 57% of the students said that if there was a dance, they would not attend. Some of the activities the students would like to have included in the Daybreak Celebration are a bounce house (\$1,700), a photo booth (\$450) and ice cream (\$1,000).

Allergy Presentation- Andrea McGrath, Amy Burkett, Tina Caruana

- The Allergy Moms presented food allergy tips for PTOs. They all have children with allergies and they have been meeting with the school district in order to bring awareness of allergies. They advocate for the inclusion and safety of students with allergies. 1 in 13 kids are affected by the Top 9 Allergens as well as gluten, milk & others. When food is available at PTO sponsored events, in order for all students to be safely included, it is helpful to have a list of student allergies, designate an allergen free table & use a teal tablecloth, have signs listing any allergens in the food being served, indicate if there will be allergy friendly foods on event flyers, ask outside food vendors to provide lists of allergens as well as allergy friendly food options.
- At the OPHS, they are working with the school to have a list of kids with allergies and medical conditions available at school dances so if something happens, they know of the issues. They also request that a nurse is at school events in case of a student emergency.

PTO Teachers Representative Report-Mrs. Baumgartner

- If a teacher grant request is above \$75.00, it must be presented to the School Board for approval.
- One new teacher grant request was presented. Margaret Staebell has a request for 10 cordless microscopes. The current microscopes have been in use for 20 to 30+ years. The NYS lab requires students to observe specimens

that are more difficult to focus & require equipment with greater visual acuity. The purchase would benefit 7th & 8th grade students (primarily 8th grade). The microscopes cost \$229 each, so the request is for \$2,290 or less depending on the status of an additional request for a grant to help with the purchase.

Mr. Wolf is going to inquire with the School District to see if they can help with the funding. The request is being temporarily held until more information is available.

Treasurer's Report- Jennifer Kellington

- Treasurer's Report from January 9, 2024 through February 12, 2024 is attached.
- A check from the Citrus Sale is expected to be received this week & the ongoing School Supply Sale funds will also be checked this week.

President's Report- Tara Womble

- The grant request from Mr. Bischof has been fulfilled.
- The School Board will vote on the two remaining grant requests at their meeting next month.
- The elementary schools have been asked to post the open Membership Toolkit position for the new school year.

Committee Reports

- Spring Book Fair (03/07/2024 to coincide with the STEAM Expo)- Jennifer Kellington & Susan McNeill: The Book Fair will run from 5:30pm to 8:30pm, which is just before the STEAM Expo starts & runs a bit after the Expo ends, to allow students & families enough time to enjoy both events. We are waiting to hear from the Tech Department where in the school we can set up the Fair. We are working with Scholastic. Flyers will be available to all students in their homerooms. Once we sell \$3,500 at the event, we can start receiving cash instead of Scholastic Dollars. We need to sell over \$6,000 of merchandise at the Fair to reach the budgeted income of \$1,500 in cash. We currently have \$1,023 in Scholastic Dollars from previous Fairs that can be spent. These funds can be used to purchase library bound books for the library that have a lifetime warranty on the bindings. We can also look to fulfill teacher grant requests with Scholastic Dollars. We will wait until after the March 7th Book Fair before deciding how the Scholastic Dollars should be spent.
- Spring Fun Nights: There is not an 8th Grade Spring Activity Night since they will have their Daybreak Celebration on June 7th. The 6th & 7th Grade Activity Night is being held on May 10th. The budget for this event needs to be increased from \$1,800 to \$2,600. A vote was taken & the increase was approved. There will not be a Spring Fun Night for the 7th grade going forward since the 7th Grade also has a Field Day in the spring.
- Color Run (5/17/24)-Tiffany Hsu & Jonelle Smith: The track at S. Davis has been pulled up & it is not yet known if it will be back in place in time for this event. It was also discussed if the event should be open to the entire school district or just the OPMS community.

• Building Effectiveness Team (BET)- Kathy Bielecki.

- Signage for parking time restrictions in the front loop of the school was discussed.
- There is currently only one printer for students to use in the library and they are looking into getting a second printer.
- Discussions continued regarding ways to increase PTO Membership. The idea of allowing people to join for free but inviting them to make a donation to the PTO, instead of requiring a \$5 membership fee, was discussed.





•We currently provide a music lesson program available for all instruments and voice during the school year, as well as a summer lesson program.




