Mr. Johnson, Principal Report

- Music ensemble starting

- Clubs also kicking off in coming weeks
- Title 1 Funds are utilized to support our ESL students in Orchard Park and for student clubs in Windom
 - Mr. Johnson is working to distribute clubs throughout the school year
 - Before and after school clubs:
 - morning club attendees will ride the middle school bus and then get onto a shuttle to take students to their respective elementary buildings
- School Musical is in the planning stages, but is so exciting; but in the works are all the COVID policies and procedures to keep everyone safe
- You won't want to miss this show so exciting, even Mr. Johnson wants to audition for the lead!
- Refreshing to have activities returning to the students of Windom: the kids deserve these opportunities
- No school Monday, October 11, 2021
- Parent teacher conferences in December: in person and virtual options will be available
 - The goal is 100% parent/family participation for conferences
- Arrival/ Dismissal:

- Windom is on the border of Hamburg and the houses affected are within the Hamburg jurisdiction, and Mr. Johnson and the district are working with the town to find solutions
- No standing and no parking signs are being installed on Sheldon due to neighborhood complaints; concerns that parents could get ticketed for standing/parking soon
- Looking for modification as to how the line is running to eliminate congestion and support neighborhood concerns
 - Possible solution is to enter the parking lot and loop left to allow more vehicles to wait within the parking lot as opposed to waiting on Sheldon

- Parents please do not line up prior to 8:35 in the morning or 2:45 in the afternoon on Sheldon as the neighbors are not happy
- Mr. Johnson and the district are working with the Town of Hamburg to clear up the congestion and work collaboratively to solve this concern.

Mrs. Hanlon, Teacher Report

 - Everyone so appreciative
