**Abbott and Fenner Scholarship-** This \$1,000 scholarship is available to seniors who plan to continue their education beyond high school. To apply, students must write an essay on the following topic: *Describe your educational, career, and life goals. Explain your plan for achieving these goals. **AES Engineering Scholarship-** AES Engineering offers \$500 scholarships to seniors planning to attend a post-secondary educational program.
